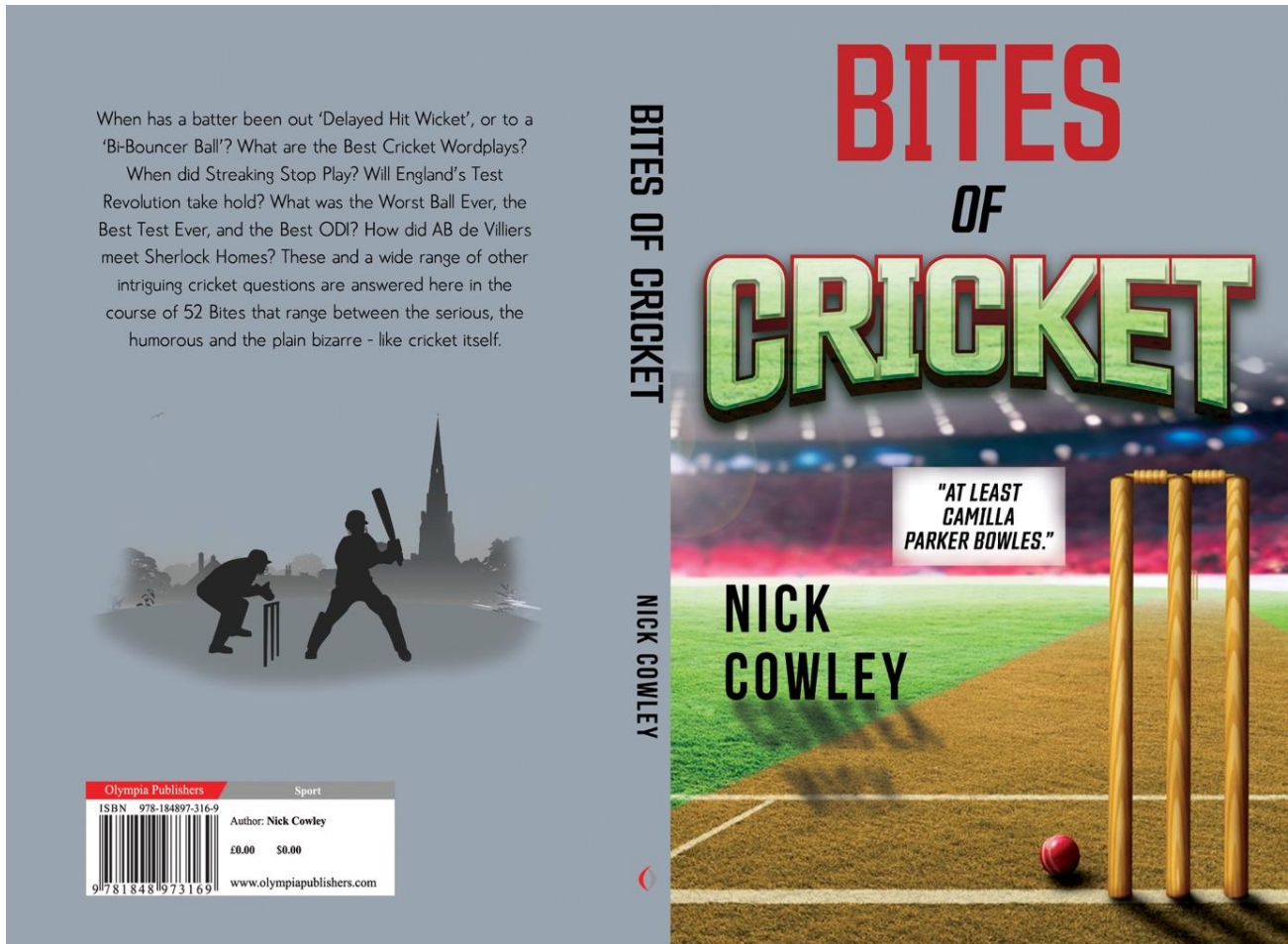


Recent Publications

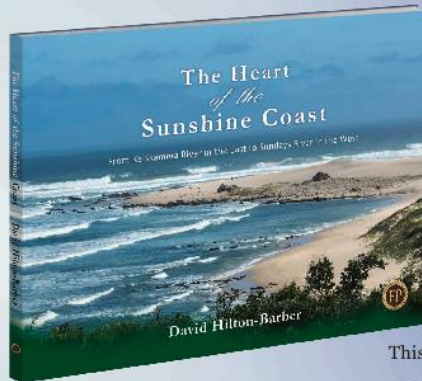

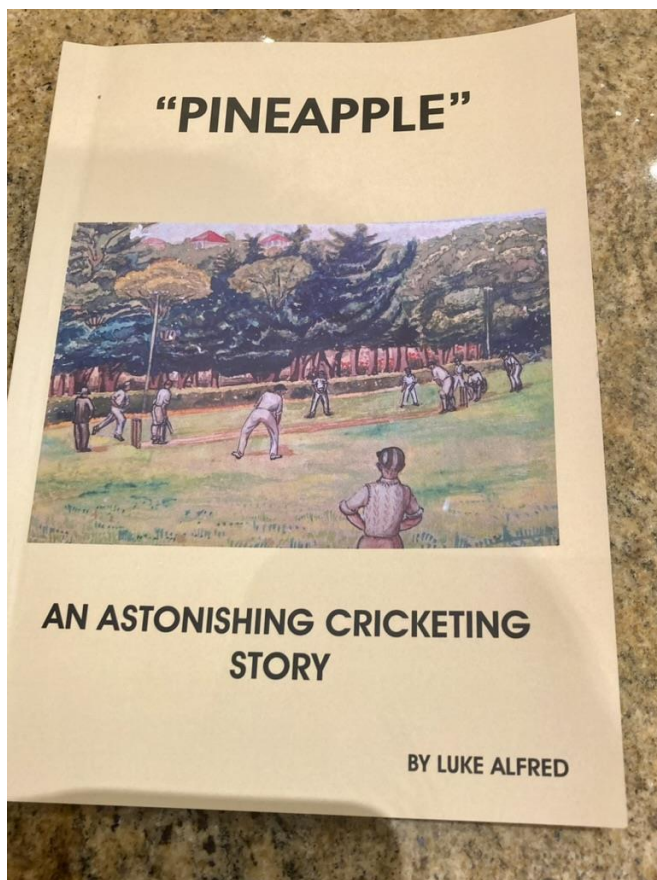
